- Women-owned businesses drive the U.S. economy
- They represent 39.1% of all businesses, employ 12.2mil workers, and **generate \$2.7 trillion in revenue**
- Women-owned businesses increased at nearly double the rate of their male counterparts since 2021
- Black and Latina women-owned businesses increased the most of all women-owned businesses
- Nearly half a million women-owned businesses grew their aggregate revenues by about 30% in 2023

## **2024 Economic Impact**

- Served 17,129 clients, a 21% increase from the previous year
- Created and retained 26,761 jobs, reflecting a 21% growth from 2023
- Facilitated \$36 million in business capital access, with 85% of financing going to women-owned businesses and 71% to businesses owned by women of color
- Generated \$785.5 million in local economic value, a 36% increase from 2023
- For every \$1 of funding received, the Network generates \$79 in local economic benefits

#### 2024 Childcare Businesses

- 5,106 childcare slots created a 50% increase from the previous year
- 1,176 Childcare entrepreneurs received assistance to start childcare businesses
- 550 New or expanding childcare businesses assisted up 23% from the previous year

## **Expanding Services in 2025**

- WBCs provide low-cost or free support services in 53 of California's 58 counties and in 20 languages
- The Network will add three new centers in the Los Angeles region to extend services and increase economic impact
